Expansion update – August 2010



This was the infant playground looking from the nursery towards the entrance (gate in middle distance) to the walkway leading to and from the Upper Richmond Road West.



This infant playground again, looking towards what was the infant cloakroom, in preparation for the further building work.



This was the state of the hall in August. It was used as a storage area during the summer as extensive work was carried out on the kitchen, the staff room area, and corridor leading to the junior's area, among other things.



This is the inside of one of the classrooms with still some work to do. However, hopefully you can see from a day which was overcast and dark, and with no artificial lighting at all, it is still very well lit. We hope one set of four classrooms will be handed over to us the beginning of October, with the other another four classrooms being handed over a week or two later in October.



This is the view from outside looking into the classrooms. The glass panels have a large sliding section as well as a door so that the classroom can be enclosed, partially open or fully open.



This is what used to be the junior playground. You can see the willow tree and the storage pavilion. The pavilion is being replaced by a large metal container that will have much more storage; it will also be 'camouflaged' to blend in with the landscape.



This is what used to be the playing field, looking towards the allotments. This is how it looked first thing on the morning this photo was taken (27 Aug 2010).



This is how it looked less than two hours later. The turf needs time to bed in and will not be used until the end of November. It will be in even better condition if we do not use it until after Christmas.



This was the state of, what is called, the MUGA (multi use games area). It will have a final coating of fine tarmac and is probably about twice the size as shown in this photograph. The playing field is further back, behind the shed. The MUGA will be available for the children's use once term starts.



This picture shows a shared area outside the classrooms, which are to the right as you look at it. The white doors to the left (shown in this photo) are cloakrooms. This area will be mirrored in the other block of four classrooms. Once again, on an overcast day with no lighting it is an area that is naturally well lit.



This is an example of a storage area in one of the classrooms. Corkboards will also be incorporated into the walls.



This is another view of a shared area with lots of light coming in from the roof lights. Each classroom has a large window so that staff can see into the shared area.



This is the new infant playground and situated next to the playing field area (the Catholic church wall is on the right) and outside the temporary classrooms. The black tarmac is another small MUGA and the green section is a soft play surface that now houses the activity frame that used to be in the infant playground outside the hall.
